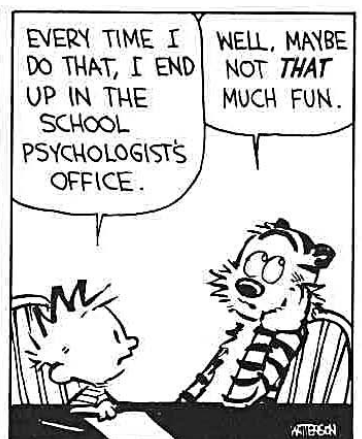
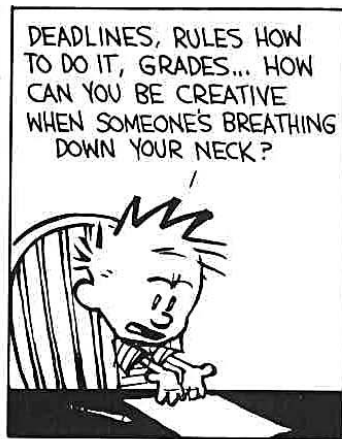
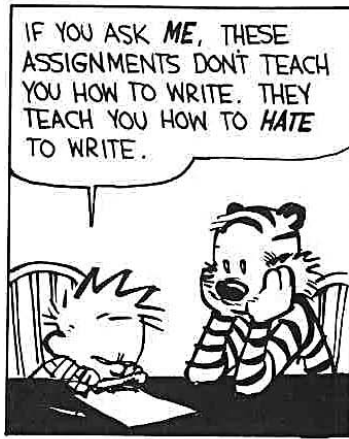
Tuesday:
