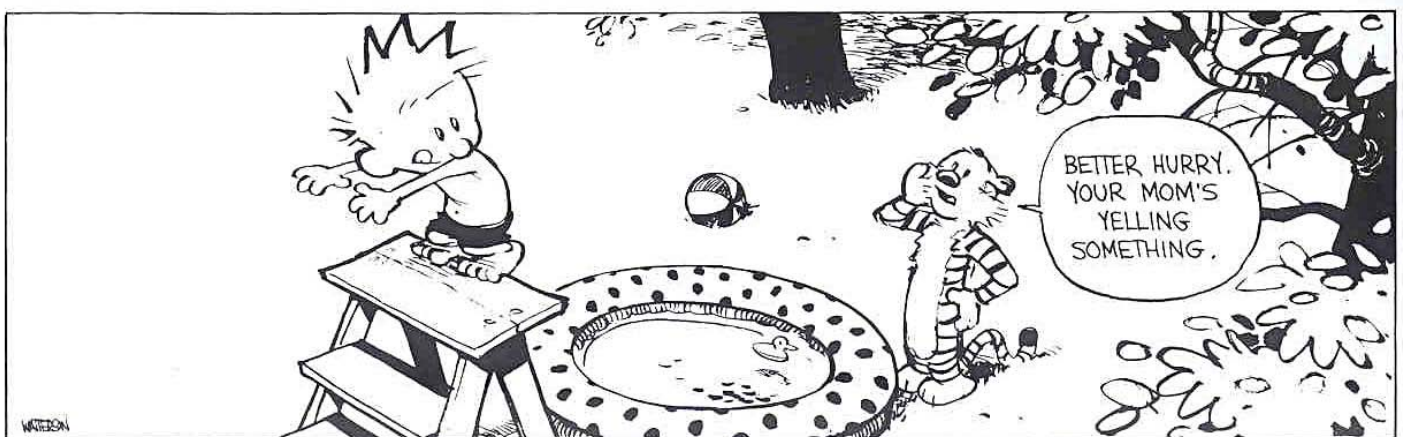
Thursday:
